Audiovisual Borrowing Policy

Flint Public Library's Board of Trustees has adopted the following policy governing the borrowing of DVDs, CDs, and Playaways:

- 1. The borrower assumes full responsibility for the careful use of the DVD/CD/Playaway. If an item is lost or damaged, full replacement cost will be charged.
- 2. The loan period for a DVD is one week, with one renewal. The loan period for CDs and Playaways is 3 weeks, with one renewal. Renewal of an item will not be processed if other patrons are waiting for the item.
- 3. Overdue audiovisual materials are subject to the same restrictions as overdue books and may result in the loss of borrowing privileges in the network.
- 4. Audiovisual materials may be returned at either the Circulation Desks or in the designated Audiovisual Drop Box outside the building.
- 5. The library is not responsible for any damage caused to the borrower's DVD or CD player by a borrowed DVD or CD.
- 6. The copyright proprietor has licensed content of the DVD/CD for private home use or non-theatrical use only and prohibits any other use, copying, reproduction, or performance in public, in whole or in part. [U.S. Code, Title 17, Sec. 501-506]
