

POLICY ON DISCOUNT PASSES/TICKETS TO MUSEUMS AND OTHER ATTRACTIONS

The Trustees of the Flint Public Library have adopted the following policy governing the circulation of Passes and Tickets:

Definitions: Passes are usually laminated and are for specific days of the week; they are to be shown at the “museum” entrance and must be returned to the Library after use. Tickets are paper and are for specific dates; they are to be filled out and turned in at the “museum” entrance.

1. In that they may reserve Passes and Tickets in advance for specific dates, with one exception Middleton residents are given priority over non-residents. The exception: Non-residents who join the Friends of the Flint at the level of \$25/year or above may also reserve Passes and Tickets in advance.

2. Passes are generally due on the day following their use.

(NOTE: Same-day return may be required to guarantee optimal use of Passes.)

3. Passes may be returned to one of the two Circulation Desks or, in a plastic container, to the Book or Audiovisual Return on the face of the building.

4. There will be a \$5.00 fine if a Pass is not returned within 24 hours of its due date.

5. A replacement fee will be levied if a Pass is lost.
