

AUDIO VISUAL BORROWING POLICY

The Board of Trustees of the Flint Public Library have adopted the following policy governing the borrowing of videos, DVDs, CDs, and Play-Away's:

1. The borrower assumes full responsibility for the careful use of the Video/DVD/CD/Play-away. If an item is lost or damaged, full replacement cost will be charged.
2. The loan period for a video or DVD is one week, with one renewal (unless there is a waiting list for that item). The loan period for CD's and Play-away's is 3 weeks.
3. Overdue audiovisual materials are subject to the same restrictions as overdue books and may result in the loss of borrowing privileges in the network.
4. All audiovisual materials must be returned to one of the two Circulation Desks or in the designated Audiovisual Drop box from the outside of the building.
5. The library is not responsible for any damage caused to the borrower's video/DVD/CD player by a borrowed video/DVD/CD.
6. The copyright proprietor has licensed content of the video/DVD/CD's for private home use or non-theatrical use only and prohibits any other use, copying, reproduction, or performance in public, in whole or in part. [*U.S. Code, Title 17, Sec. 501-506*]
