Guidelines for pre-K through Grade 6

- Register your child(ren) for the summer reading program by visiting us in the children's room or by emailing our Children's Collection Development and Outreach Librarian, Stacey Zubiel, at SZubiel@flintpublib.org.
- A reading log is provided for you to track your reading time. Fill in 1 clock for every 15 minutes of reading. Each block of 20 clocks is equal to 5 hours of reading. Reading logs are available for pickup at the library or can be emailed to be printed at home.
- Over the course of the summer, track and log your child(ren)'s reading with our clock sheet reading logs.
- For every 5 hours (20 clocks, or quarter-page) of reading completed, children may choose a book and a toy prize from the currently available book and toy prize options. Prizes vary, and are given on a first-come, first-served basis. Toy and book prizes will be limited to eight (8) per child over the course of the summer, though reading may be logged beyond this point if desired.
- All reading counts! Make sure to track all time you are being read to, reading audiobooks, graphic novels, comics, magazines, and re-reading favorites!
- <u>Children entering grades K-6 who complete and log 20 or more hours of</u> reading by **August 16th** are eligible to receive prizes from Topsfield Fair.
